On a Taddie/Sasala motion Dan Bell was employed as head custodian at \$11.91 per hour, with a 30-day probationary period as per the Collective Bargaining Agreement, retroactive to July 18, 2008. Poll vote; motion carried 6-0.

On a Thomas/Yurky motion Don Brown was employed as an eight-hour custodian at \$9.15 per hour, with a 30-day probationary period as per the Collective Bargaining Agreement, effective August 11, 2008. Poll vote; 6-0.

On a Sasala/Taddie motion Miss Elizabeth Paddock was employed as temporary professional employee in the area of elementary education, subject to administrative assignment at a starting salary of \$52,033. This employment will be effective August 21, 2008, and will be governed by terms and conditions of the current Collective Bargaining Agreement. Poll vote; motion carried 6-0.

On a Bertig/Sasala motion Mrs. Karen Woods was employed as a professional employee in the area of secondary health and physical education, subject to administrative assignment at a starting salary of \$54,233.
